

## **River Rejuvenation Project**

The aim of this project was for Collection of Water for village to support the Government of Gujarat's (GoG) new flagship programme named Sujalam Suflam Jal Sanchay Abhiyan to make Gujarat a drought-free state by 2021. The project involves deepening and widening of streams, , improve nullahs and digging of farm ponds with a target to make 5,000 villages free of water scarcity every single year.

Drishti Foundation Trust decided to refurbish Pundrashan village pond in Taluka Kalol which is a in District Gandhinagar in Gujarat state. We decided to refurbish on River Bogawo which is in Loliya Taluka of Gujarat Ahmedabad district.
